Instructions

Charging

The wrap has a built-in battery that may be charged with the included USB > Type-C cable.
Charge the device for 2 hours.
The device has a battery life of up to 1 hour of continuous use (or 4 applications).

If the lights begin to dim, it's


time to charge.



Application

- The hock wrap can be used on either hock.
- Ensure the hole is facing backwards.
- Wrap snugly so that the LEDs are pressed against the skin for maximum efficacy.



Usage

- Press the power button once to activate both wavelengths.
- Press the power button twice to activate red light (660nm) only.
- Press the power button three times to activate near infrared light (850nm) only.
 This setting will not produce visible light as NIR light is invisible to the human eye.
- Press the power button one more time until the green light turns off. The device has powered off.
- Press the power button and hold for 3 seconds to activate the pulsing mode, then you can cycle through the settings again.

Usage Guidelines

- Never use over a cancerous growth.
- Do not use on recent burns.
- Do not use over the thyroid if the horse has hyperthyroidism.
- Consult a veterinarian before use on lame, ill, pregnant, or young horses.
